

Below are some of our most Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

1) What do you guys do ?

Hawaiian Hope is a technology-based Non-profit Organization with the objective to address the parallel issues of homeless services and disaster management. We are self funded with **NO** government grants of any kind (your tax dollars) and have been in operations for over 6 years.

Hawaiian Hope has seven different primary projects. Some of these projects include :

* **Computer Recycling** : Using donated computers, we build computer classrooms in homeless shelters, give free computers to individuals and families and help change lives. These computers are used by children to complete schoolwork and by adults to fill out job applications. In addition, we give free computers to individuals and families when they move out of the shelters and back into housing.

To date we have redistributed over 900 FREE computers !

* **Web Based Data Systems** : Hawaiian Hope designs web-based data management tools for organizations to manage their facilities and day-to-day operations. We currently manage the data of several of the states largest homeless shelters and the personal data of over 11,400 individuals.

* **Tech Training** : We train people that are interested in learning technology and teach them useful skills for the work-field. We have helped a variety of people including homeless, single moms, recovering addicts, our youth in the community and have also participated in techs improving their own skills.
